The Association is proud of the part it has been able to play in providing finance for those areas of the cathedral which would otherwise received little funding and also the financial support we have given to the major projects.

Recently we have financed the Chapter House heating, the lighting in St Hugh's Choir, established a bursary for a friends' Chorister, financed a yearly choral scholar, provided the materials for the Hassocks in the choir, vestments for the clergy and altar hangings.

We have made yearly grants to the Library for the ongoing restoration and preservation of rare books. We enabled the restoration of the great Father Willis Organ and have provided substantial funds for the new toilets

There is always much to do and we hope you will join us.

In 1987 The Young Friends group was formed and this has proved to be another successful venture.
